

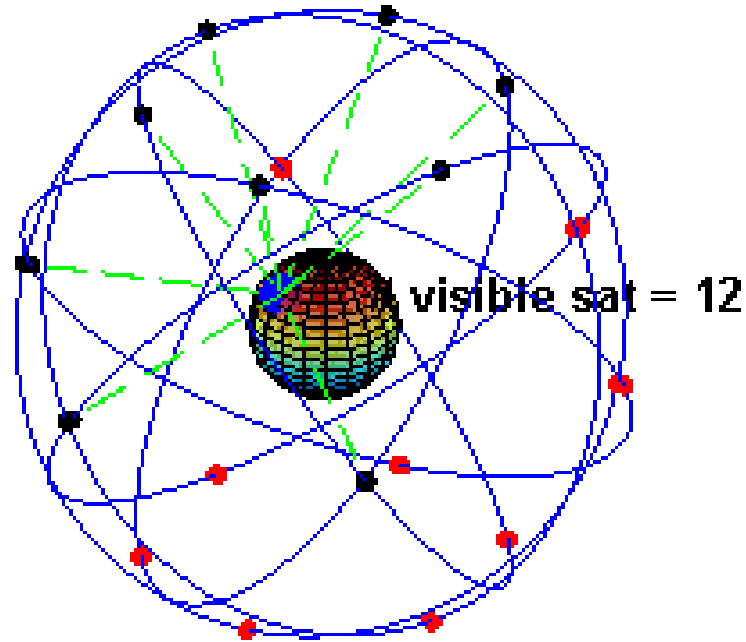


Status of Preparation
