

Sun Temple and Heliophysics at Amvalkheda, India

The Sun, our life, has fascinated mankind from ancient times. From religion to myth and from history to science, the Sun has always retained a central position in our consciousness. India, Hindu mythology and the Indian people are also part of this long history. But, as we all know, there must be a scientific basis behind each story if you want to create a new and long lasting era.



Divine vision of the Sun

My master, sage of the era, writer of more than 3200 books and translator of Vedas “Yugrishi Pt. Shri Ram Sharma Acharyaji” chose the sun as his goal and always represented solar science very sympathetically in his books, lectures and letters. He spread awareness of the Sun and Gayatri (the ancient spell of solar energy) to hundreds of millions during his life. All World Gayatri Pariwar, one of the biggest NGOs in the world, is constructing a Sun Temple as a homage to him at his birth place and as a tribute to his divine vision of the Sun.

Sun Temple

We, All World Gayatri Pariwar (www.awgp.org, www.dsvv.ac.in), are constructing a very large Sun Temple, the first its kind in India at Amvalkheda, North India. The Temple will be multi-storied and will cover an area of more than 25 000 square feet. We plan to show all aspects of the Sun, from its ancient Vaidic definition and terminology to current heliophysics. This will help to train a new generation in solar science in a scientific way which is not currently performed elsewhere.



The Temple

In the Temple there will be a statue of the sun god on a chariot being pulled by seven horses (representing the seven parts of the spectrum) which will be illuminated by actual sunlight from a large lens on the top of temple (kindly see the pictures). There will be a book stall with books on solar science from the Vaidik age to the present and a display on Hindu solar mythology. There will also be Radio Jove from NASA, Super Sid from the Stanford Solar Center, pin hole cameras for long exposure of the ecliptic, large pictures of the Sun from SDO, STEREO etc., a live feed from SDO, recordings of solar storms, a multimedia show and a live kiosk to answer visitors' questions will be there to represent Heliophysics in its purest form. At the top of the dome, there will be a large solar telescope.



Regular education for students

In addition to the three girls colleges in the region we will regularly invite students, the young and the general public to learn about the Sun, space weather and its effect on our day to day lives, the solar system and much more. We will also invite prominent speakers on various occasions not only from India but also from the rest of the world. Regular multimedia shows will be performed featuring the latest information, events and science of the Sun.
